

Alistair & Judith McCrone Graduate Fellowship Award

Humboldt State University established the Alistair and Judith McCrone Graduate Fellowship Fund in October 2001. The fund was created to honor Dr. and Mrs. McCrone, who together shepherded Humboldt State University and its students for over a quarter of a century. This award will recognize one outstanding graduate student, acknowledge their potential, and encourage their continued achievement in their graduate program.

The following provides specific information about the award:

- First year students who have been in their HSU Graduate Program for less than one academic year are eligible for nominations
- One award of \$3,000 will be applied to their tuition for use in Academic Year 2021-2022
- Graduate students must be enrolled full time (at least 9 units per semester), and have at least a 3.0 GPA
- Only one candidate may be nominated per graduate degree program. Graduate programs that have more than one option (not emphasis) may nominate up to one candidate from each option.
- Completed nominations must be submitted electronically by the Graduate Program Coordinator and through <u>InfoReady</u> by <u>Monday</u>, <u>February 15, 2021 by 5:00pm</u>. Incomplete or late nominations will not be considered.

Awards will be presented at a virtual reception held later this spring (date TBD). The recipient *must be available to attend* the virtual reception and give a short presentation of their research.
