About the Award

This award honors early-career Cal Poly Humboldt faculty for excellence in research and scholarship. It acknowledges potential in their field and encourages continued achievement.

Eligibility

Open to tenured/tenure-track faculty from any discipline who earned their terminal degree within the past 7 years and are actively engaged in research. Self-nominations are accepted.

Award Details

\$1,500 per awardee, to support scholarly or creative activities.

Nomination Process

- Submit a nomination letter (max 2 pages) through InfoReady via Engagement Hub.
- Eligible nominees will be invited to submit:
 - A current curriculum vitae
 - A brief (max 2 pages) research statement

Key Dates

- Nomination Deadline: Thursday, February 26, 2026 @ 11:59 p.m.
- Award Reception: **Tuesday, November 10, 2026** | 4–6 p.m. (recipient must be able to attend in person and give a short presentation)
- Award Notification: No later than April 15, 2026

Selection Process

The Planning Committee for Research, Scholarship & Creative Activities, with input from a previous Scholar of the Year, will select up to three recipients.
